Tom Thomason joined the American Chamber of Commerce in Egypt in 1994. He has served as AmCham executive vice president, chair of the Engineering & Construction Committee and is currently on the Board of Governors serving as vice president, legal affairs. He also serves on the boards of the Bilateral Fulbright Commission and the American University in Cairo.

Mr. Thomason is vice president of Globeleq, which develops, owns and operates power plants and related fuel and electricity infrastructure with investments in 19 energy assets in 14 countries.

Joined by Edison SPA of Italy, Globeleq is the owner/operator of Egypt's first privately owned and operated power plant, a \$480 million project completed in January 2002 and now in operation selling electricity to the government.
